Applying for designation as a neighbourhood planning area for parishes is fairly straight forward.

If you are an existing parish then under the terms of the Localism Act you are a "relevant body".

What happens after submitting an application?

As soon as receiving an application from your parish council your local planning authority must publicise your application on their web site, and in other appropriate ways. They must also tell people who live in the

area, and businesses, how they can make representations on your application. The period for making representations must last at least six weeks.

After the consultation period, the local planning authority then have to decide whether to designate the area you have identified as neighbourhood а planning area, or not. In both cases this decision has to be publicised.
